Your 10-week externship will include working one-on-one with a RN Mentor, as well as time with fellow externs in a classroom setting.

Ideal candidates will be purpose-driven individuals who thrive on hard work and are committed to giving their best every day to make a meaningful difference in the lives of others. Student applicants must be currently enrolled in an accredited nursing school (BSN or BSN/MN program) and entering their last year or semester, or accredited ADN program entering their last semester upon completion of their externship. Candidates must hold Basic Life Support certification through the American Heart Association for the duration of the program.

What locations are the externships available at?

Externships are available at Cleveland Clinic's regional hospitals in Florida. See attached map for reference. The 10-week program will be, June 3-August 10, 2024

How can I apply?

Applications are being accepted from December 1, 2023 - February 1, 2024. Please visit clevelandclinic.jobs and search **237870** for Weston location and **238255** for Martin Health location to submit your application and/or résumé. If you are a current caregiver, please be sure to indicate your Cleveland Clinic affiliation.

What can I expect after I submit my application?

If you meet the program requirements, you will receive an email to complete a preferences form and schedule a recruiter intake call. Finalists will move forward to a virtual or live interview with a nurse leader.

What hours will I work?

As a Nurse Associate, you will be expected to work full time (40 hours per week). You will be scheduled for 8- or 12-hour shifts, depending on your nurse mentor's schedule.

Is the externship paid?

Yes, this externship is a paid opportunity.
