


Vascular Lab Services

Our staff of vascular technologists is dedicated to providing you with the most timely and detailed non-invasive vascular studies possible to help determine the best plan of care for patients with arterial and venous disease.



Diagnosis of vascular disease begins in our offices with a careful medical history, including risk factors and a brief vascular physical exam. This information helps our vascular technologists focus on specific arteries and veins that may be contributing to the patient's symptoms.

The non-invasive testing performed in our labs utilizes various types of state-of-the-art technology to evaluate arterial blood flow within the vessels at rest and with exercise and venous blood flow. These exams are painless and risk-free and can help to determine if arterial or venous disease is present, and if so, the location and severity. The information obtained from our thorough vascular exams allows for accurate and appropriate decision-making regarding further testing such as angiography and types of treatment (surgical, endovascular or medical).

Reports

Our labs provide referring physicians with clear and comprehensive reports. Abnormal or concerning test results are phoned to the referring physician immediately. In all cases, a preliminary report is faxed to the referring physician on the same day the test is performed.

Equipment

Our vascular labs feature the latest arterial and venous physiology and duplex ultrasound equipment with advanced imaging capabilities.

Expertise


Our labs are among the busiest in the country and are run by knowledgeable and well-trained staff, all of whom are committed to the highest standards of quality patient care and monitoring. Tests are performed by registered vascular technologists and interpreted by board-certified vascular medical or surgical specialists, all of whom are also registered vascular technologists (RVT) and/or registered physicians in vascular interpretation (RPVI).

Our Vascular Labs are accredited by the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (IAC) and staffed by registered vascular technologists (RVT). Our Registered Vascular Technologists have extensive experience performing non-invasive vascular testing, with several having more than 15 years of experience performing these evaluations.

Guidelines for Scheduling Tests

All tests generally require 60 minutes to perform except Renal/ Mesenteric Arterial Duplex, which requires 90 minutes.

A 12-hour fast is required for testing within the abdominal area. An empty abdomen/intestines allow for a faster and more accurate test due to less bowel gas that may cause artifact and difficulty visualizing abdominal arteries and veins.

 To determine deep and superficial vein thrombosis

 To determine primary and/or secondary varicose veins

 To determine the cause of leg swelling

Upper and Lower Extremity Arterial Evaluation

- · Pulse volume recordings

- · Photoplethysmography
- Exercise testing

 To determine significance of arterial stenosis

Abdominal Aorta and Renal/Visceral Artery Evaluations*

 To assess the abdominal aorta and iliac arteries
 To determine degree of renal/visceral stenosis
- Abdominal aneurysm surveillance
- · Renal artery duplex stent surveillance

^{*}Requires a 12-hour fast (nothing to eat or drink, but may take medications with sips of water)

Clinical Indications for a Test

Carotid:

Carotid Bruit

Extremity weakness or numbness

Difficulty speaking

Loss of vision in one eye

Dizziness, problems with balance

Syncope

Following carotid endartectomy or stenting

Transient ischemic attack - TIA or "mini-stroke"

Surveillance of known stenosis of internal carotid artery

Venous:

Leg swelling

Leg pain

Leg ulcer

Painful varicose veins

Suspected deep vein thrombosis

Arterial:

Claudication

Rest pain

Gangrene

Ischemic leg or foot ulcerations

Diabetic foot evaluation

Suspected Raynaud's disease

Suspected thoracic outlet syndrome

Leg artery aneurysms

Leg/Arm artery pseudoaneurysms

Leg bypass graft surveillance

Assessment of hemodialysis access (fistula or graft)

Abdominal:

Abdominal aortic aneurysm

Aorto-Iliac occlusive disease

Renovascular hypertension

Renal insufficiency

Abdominal pain after eating, with weight loss

Chronic mesenteric ischemia
