## 2019 UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH POSTER COMPETITION GUIDELINES

### **POSTER CONTENT**

The poster should be sufficient to technically explain and illustrate the research project to the audience and the judges. Presenters should carefully critique the content and arrangement of their posters. The flow of information in the poster layout should be done in a way that easily reveals the research process and addresses significant points.

It is recommended that the poster contain (at minimum) the following sections:

- Abstract
- Introduction
- Research and Methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- References

The data should be clear, concise and well-organized. Please bring five copies of any supplementary research data or updates for the judges.

#### **POSTER PRODUCTION**

Cleveland Clinic's Medical Art & Photography Department, who produce posters for our staff physicians and researchers, will produce all competition posters. Students selected to present their research must submit a completed one-page poster in a PDF or PowerPoint file to <u>diversity4u@ccf.org</u> by Friday, April 19, 2019. Once received, the poster will be mounted to a display board by Cleveland Clinic. The poster will be available for presenters upon arrival to the research poster competition.

#### **PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

Presenters will be given five minutes to make an oral presentation followed by five minutes of questions and answers from the panel of judges. Presenters will be judged on the appearance/clarity of poster, research and methods, oral presentation, and ability to answer questions.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

Scholarship awards are presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers in the following amounts:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$1,500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$1,250
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: \$1,000
