### Art Exhibition: FRONT

Cleveland Clinic is a partnering institution with FRONT International: Cleveland Triennial for Contemporary Art. In the Julia and Larry Pollock Gallery, conceptual artist **Sharon Lockhart** will present an installation which includes a series of large format photographs of Polish young girls, specially designed benches and newspapers. Additionally, a dynamic abstract wall painting by **Jan van der Ploeg** has been painted on site near the H elevators. It will be on view throughout the exhibition.

FRONT is an exhibition comprised of artist commissions, performances, films, and public programs that will launch its inaugural edition in July of 2018. *An American City: Eleven Cultural Exercises*, in collaboration with museums, civic institutions, and alternative spaces across Cleveland, Akron and Oberlin, will showcase over 100 ambitious projects, including performance and theater throughout the landscape and built environment. With a roster of national, international and area-based artists at all points in their career, FRONT will examine the ever-changing and politically urgent conditions of an American city.
