A Maker's Mark introduces a group of emerging and local artists that apply non-traditional methods to the typical instruments of art-making. Using a series of innovative processes, these artists create objects that are layered in both surface and meaning. While some of these works incorporate similar media, each artist's distinctive practice and technical fluidity evolves into a unique result. In turn, these dynamic structures produce a narrative that challenges the viewer's understanding of the marks and their makers. The opportunity to see these works side-by-side highlights the array of surprising materials and experimental approaches that contemporary artists are currently exploring.
