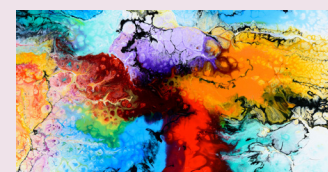

Art Exhibition: FRONT

Julia and Larry Pollock Gallery and Near the H Elevators

Cleveland Clinic is a partnering institution with FRONT International: Cleveland Triennial for Contemporary Art. In the Julia and Larry Pollock Gallery, conceptual artist **Sharon Lockhart** will present an installation which includes a series of large format photographs of Polish young girls, specially designed benches and newspapers. Additionally, a dynamic abstract wall painting by **Jan van der Ploeg** will be painted on site near the H elevators during the first week in July and on view throughout the exhibition.

FRONT is an exhibition comprised of artist commissions, performances, films, and public programs that will launch its inaugural edition in July of 2018. *An American City: Eleven Cultural Exercises*, in collaboration with museums, civic institutions, and alternative spaces across Cleveland, Akron and Oberlin, will showcase over 100 ambitious projects, including performance and theater throughout the landscape and built environment. With a roster of national, international and area-based artists at all points in their career, FRONT will examine the ever-changing and politically urgent conditions of an American city.
