Art Exhibition: Caregiver Art Show

January 23–March 11, 2019

The 2019 Caregiver Art Show will feature photographs, paintings, drawings, and other creative two- and three-dimensional artworks made by Cleveland Clinic caregivers from across the health system. This exhibition is an opportunity for employees to share their artistic talents with co-workers, patients, and the greater community. Caregiver artists from main campus, seven regional hospitals, family health centers, and administrative locations as far as Columbus submitted 195 entries for review. A selection of 115 artworks were chosen by a jury of art professionals from the Cleveland community, including Will Brown, Assistant Curator at Museum of Contemporary Art Cleveland; Elizabeth Emery, local artist; and Emily Liebert, Associate Curator of Contemporary Art at Cleveland Museum of Art.
