This course could be just what you are looking for.

Course Description

This course is approved by the Center for Health Sciences Education and is one of 14 internal health education programs at the Cleveland Clinic Enterprise. The course supports the RN to achieve the theoretical, practical, and clinical skills necessary for safely providing manual and touch therapies within their scope of practice, to patients with a wide range of special medical needs.

This course consists of 40 hours of classroom, lab practicals, group and individual clinical rounding, 25 hours of home study, and supervised independent clinical experience. The majority of the supervised clinical experience will be scheduled on the student's nursing unit, therefore benefiting their patients, families, and staff. The achievement of clinical requirements is facilitated through a competency based checklist.
