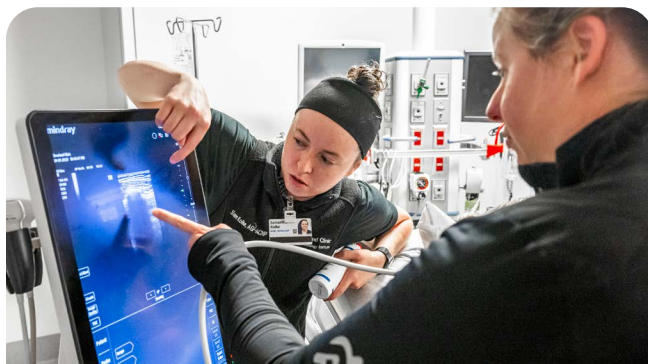


Simulation Facilitator Training Programs

The Simulation and Advanced Skills Center will require and track simulation faculty development completion for all educators and clinicians using simulation resources.

Two training programs are available based on the type of simulation used in a course.



Skills Facilitation Program

Requirement of educators facilitating technical skills training with task trainers or other non scenario based modalities (including guest clinical experts teaching skills stations).

This program includes:

- Introduction to Simulation
- Prebriefing and Preparation
- Skills Facilitation

Simulation Facilitation and Debriefing Program

Requirement of scenario-based facilitators, including those leading stand-alone simulations or simulations within larger courses.

This program includes:

- Four introductory modules
- Skills Facilitation module
- In-person/remote SEW course
