In 2005, the 1921 Society was launched as a community of donors who have made lifetime gifts of \$1 million or more to Cleveland Clinic. Since then, induction ceremonies have welcomed new members, and today, there are more than 600 individuals, families, corporations and foundations in this remarkable group.
