

Vascular Surgery Clinical Research Fellowship Opportunity

The department of Vascular Surgery within the Heart and Vascular institute is seeking candidates interested in applying for a clinical research fellowship.

The fellow's responsibilities will include;

- a. Conceptualization, design and implementation of new studies
- b. Data collection
- c. Data analysis (the division of vascular surgery has a statistician)
- d. Writing IRB protocols for current studies
- e. Work with our quality section for data analysis and research within our VQI database

This 1-to-2-year commitment is anticipated to allow the candidate to present abstracts and research at regional and national meetings.

Applicants must have completed an MD/DO or equivalent and have clinical background with interest in Vascular Surgery. The candidate should be fluent in English, spoken and written.

The applicant will have direct mentorship for the surgical staff sponsoring.
