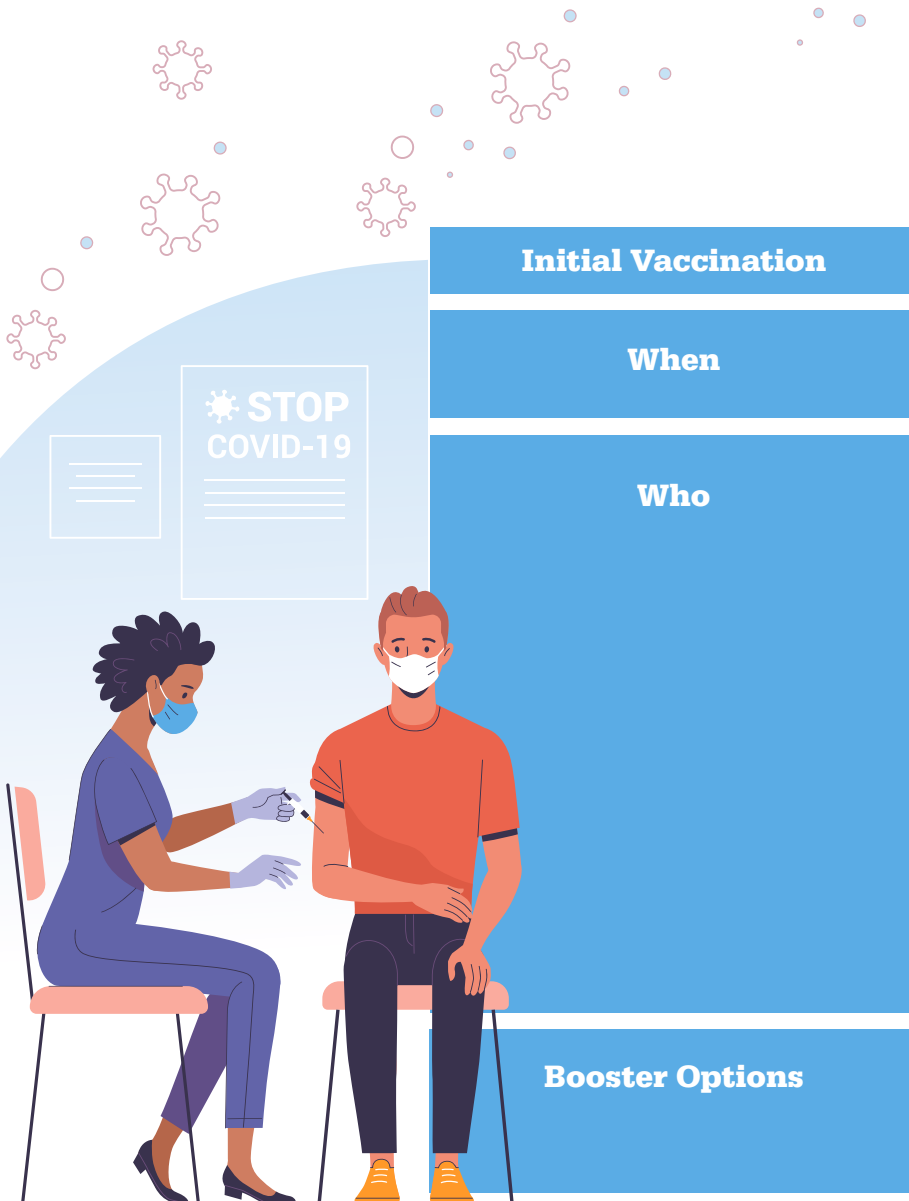


COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Shots

If you have been vaccinated against COVID-19, you may be eligible for a booster dose. Check below to find out if you qualify.

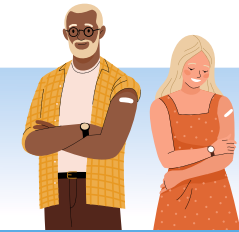
Booster Options



Johnson & Johnson

Two months after single dose.

- ▶ 18 or older.



Moderna or Pfizer/Comirnaty

Six months after second dose.

- ▶ 65 or older.
- ▶ 18 or older with **underlying health condition**.
- ▶ 18 or older living in **long-term care setting** (such as a nursing home).
- ▶ 18 or older **living in a high-risk setting** (such as a group home, jail, or homeless shelter).
- ▶ 18 or older **working in a high-risk setting**.

If you're eligible, you can choose which vaccine you receive as a booster dose. Some people may prefer the vaccine type that they originally received and others may prefer to get a different booster.

Note: If you have received a third/additional dose of the Moderna or Pfizer/Comirnaty vaccine because you are immunocompromised, you should NOT get a booster dose. No one should receive more than three doses of these vaccines at this time.
