
Use MyChart to obtain a COVID-19 self-swab test

Caregivers can now receive their Occupational Health assigned [COVID-19 test using a self-swab option](#) at select Northeast Ohio hospitals. If you believe you have COVID-19 symptoms, complete the steps below in MyChart to obtain an order for the SelfCheck® swabbing kit. It is not necessary to call the Cleveland Clinic Caregiver COVID-19 Hotline first.


1. Log in to your MyChart account.
2. From the main menu, select COVID-19 Symptom Checker.
3. Select **Ohio Caregiver COVID-19 (Coronavirus)**.

4. **Accept** the Symptom Checker Terms and Conditions.
5. Answer all questions according to your symptoms.



6. A Self-Check COVID lab order will be recommended based on your symptoms and their date of onset. Click **I accept this recommendation** to continue.
7. The order for the test will be placed and the kit can be picked up at a participating pharmacy location. Step-by-step instructions are provided.



Caregivers without symptoms who believe they have been exposed should call the Cleveland Clinic Caregiver COVID-19 Hotline at 216.445.8246. Caregivers with a positive COVID-19 test result in the last 90 days will also be required to call the hotline for next steps.
