

## Contact, Droplet and Eyewear Policy

*New policy under development in PPM*

### Key elements:

Use **Contact/Droplet and Eyewear Precautions** (with cranberry colored sign) for the following patients:


#### 1. Rule out respiratory virus

- › Includes patients being tested for flu, RSV, COVID-19, respiratory viral panel

#### 2. Positive COVID-19 patients remain in Contact/Droplet and Eyewear Precautions






- › No longer using Specified Precautions with black sign for COVID-19 positive patients

Adjust isolation based on virus identified per [Isolation for Respiratory Viruses Policy](#)

CAREGIVERS ENTERING THIS ROOM <b>MUST:</b>	
	1. <b>Perform hand hygiene</b> (soap and water or foam).
	2. <b>Before entering room:</b> Put on gown and mask. <small>*For aerosolizing procedure wear N95/PAPR</small>
	3. <b>Then</b> put on eyewear and gloves.
	4. <b>Before leaving room:</b> Remove gloves, eyewear, gown and mask.
	5. <b>Perform hand hygiene</b> (soap and water or foam).
