New order for outpatient pre-op COVID-19 testing



In accordance with updated Cleveland Clinic [COVID-19 testing guidelines](#), the “Amb Pre-Operative COVID Testing Panel” will enable routine, outpatient pre-operative testing for both adult and pediatric patients. Testing is not currently required prior to surgery.

This order should only be used in the outpatient setting for asymptomatic patients. Use of the order will be monitored by hospital and institute leadership to ensure adherence to testing guidelines.

Providers will be required to enter the patient’s preferred testing date. Upon signing, the order will be routed to a scheduling workqueue.

Process Inst.: The COVID-19 Coronavirus Panel requires one specimen collection: One nasopharyngeal specimen should be collected with a flexible mini-tip flocked swab and placed in UTM. Both the FLU/RSV and COVID tests can be performed from the same specimen. Collection devices available include Lawson # 288576 or Lawson #494611.
