COVID-19 NEGATIVE patients (by PCR or rapid test)	Use <u>standard precautions</u> in the care of all other patients based on anticipated exposure to blood & body fluid. Standard precautions may be used in addition to required PPE in patients in transmission based precaution. PPE to consider based on exposure may include some or all of the following:  • Gloves  • Face Mask • Gowns  • Eye Protection  During times of moderate to substantial community COVID-19 transmission, caregivers will wear eye protection in addition to a face mask to ensure the eyes, nose and mouth are all protected. A full face shield will be the preferred eye protection used by caregivers in clinical areas because this eye protection offers the advantage of covering and protecting the mask.
