

A required question has been added to the Rapid COVID-19 order panels in Epic to ensure patients meet the criteria for rapid testing.

Additionally, the order panel is now available to inpatient providers for testing patients requiring an emergency surgery or interventional radiology procedure within 24 hours.


Inpatient Rapid COVID-19 Order Panel

Criteria: Transplant Patient with Organ Offer Emergent Procedure/Surgery (to start in less than 24 hrs)


ED Rapid COVID-19 Order Panel

Criteria: Admit to ICU Admit to Behavioral Health Unit Admit/Triage for Labor and Delivery
Admitted to ED from Post-acute Facilities Admitted to ED who is Immunosuppressed/Has Cancer
Transplant Patient with Organ Offer Emergent Procedure/Surgery (to start in less than 24 hrs)
