## What is SelfCheck?

Selfcheck is a kit containing all elements necessary for a COVID sample to be collected without the aid of a Cleveland Clinic Caregiver, in an outpatient setting

### What is Different?

- Order placing
- No appointment for swabbing
- Patient education

## Patient SelfCheck Process







SelfCheck order placed



Patient picks up kits at any CC Pharmacy



Patient takes kit home & stores until 3 days prior to procedure




Patient follows included instruction sheet



Patient drops of collected sample in collection bin at a CC Pharmacy or Express Care

 Patient may swab on-site immediately after kit pickup if it is 3 days prior to surgery / procedure



 Patient should swab & drop off the sample the same day

 Order is in lieu of the current pre-procedure / pre-op COVID test that is performed at a swabbing location


Note: Kits cannot be obtained or returned through the mail

- Patient should be encouraged to call ahead to confirm the location's hours



## Who Can Use the SelfCheck Kit?

Patients must meet the following criteria to be eligible to use the SelfCheck COVID test kit:

- Adult (age 18+)
- English speaking

Required by the FDA

- Exclude patients from out of town / state
- Exclude Union Hospital patients
- Patient choice / ability to self swab

Epic Amb COVID Pre-Procedure Testing Panel guides you to the appropriate COVID test order

The FDA EUA does not specifically authorize the use of SelfCheck Kits for asymptomatic testing. Use for asymptomatic testing is off-label (outside the authorization) and subject to the discretion of an applicable healthcare provider ordering the test.

## How to Place the SelfCheck Order

#### AMB COVID PRE-PROCEDURE TESTING PANEL

- Search for this panel, not the order
- SelfCheck unique order name: HCCOVD
- Non-schedulable order

Intermediate (ITCOVD) COVID test is available as an option for patients outside northeast Ohio where it is not feasible for them to travel 3 days in advance for a COVID test





Messaging tool to give patients a clear timeline & direction to sources of information




Use & return your kit on the same day.

Store your kit at room temperature before and after use.

## Key Points for Patients

- Kit must be picked up from a CC pharmacy (3 months to 3 days prior to procedure)
- Kit can be stored at home, at room temperature
- Patient needs to <u>record date / time of swabbing</u> on the test order paperwork
- Patient should use the kit <u>3 days prior</u> to their procedure & drop off the sample the <u>same day</u> (CC pharmacy or Express Care)
  - A patient may pick-up, swab, & drop-off on the same day

# Other Operational Items (for surgical scheduling)

- A SelfCheck indicator added to Master Daily Schedule report in OpTime
- The Access Center is not working SelfCheck orders
  - Operators will have a script to direct the patient to the appropriate place

# Process for Incomplete Selfcheck

Patient does not drop off their swab, does not submit it in the appropriate timeframe (2-3 days prior to surgery), or the sample is unacceptable for testing (unlabeled, leaking, no swab, etc.)

An intermediate COVID test can be ordered & scheduled

Cancel HCCOVD (SelfCheck) order

Place ITCOVD order using the same order panel used for HCOVD


Schedule ITCOVID

Selfcheck order must be cancelled <u>first</u> so the intermediate COVID test order can be placed & scheduled

Walker is the only place that this test can be performed

If the there is not enough time prior to surgery to complete an intermediate COVID test, follow the process for procedure / surgery on a patient with no or expired test result
