**PLEASE NOTE:** All visitors must be at least 18 years old and wear a mask, symptom screen and sanitize their hands. Visitors to patients who are COVID-19 positive must follow safety guidelines specific to those units. If you have tested positive for COVID-19 or you have been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, you can visit a patient at least 10 days after testing positive or being exposed.

Visitation guidelines are subject to change if safe physical distancing isn't possible. Compassionate exceptions permitted when necessary.
