- Abdominal pain
- Behavioral health and chemical dependency evaluations/referrals
- Chest pain
- · Diabetes complications
- · Fractures, strains and sprains
- Minor trauma (laceration repair)
- Pediatric conditions (fever, stomach flu, bronchiolitis, dehydration, asthma)
- Severe headache
- · Stroke symptoms

While most emergencies do not require hospital admission, patients requiring inpatient care will be transported to the closest, most appropriate hospital.

- Board-certified emergency medicine physicians and physician assistants
- Registered nurses certified in adult and pediatric advanced cardiac life support
- · Paramedics, respiratory therapists and technicians

- · Expedited transfers to trauma centers
