Medina Hospital Foundation Announces Winners of \$42,000 in Scholarships

(Medina, Ohio – Thursday, April 28, 2022) Cleveland Clinic Medina Hospital, the hospital medical staff and the Medina Hospital Foundation are pleased to announce the winners of their annual scholarships for Medina County high school graduates who plan to pursue a course of study in the medical field during the 2022-23 academic year. In all, \$42,000 is being awarded.

The hospital, the staff and the foundation have collectively given more than \$740,000 in scholarships to Medina County students over the more than 75 year history of Medina Hospital.
