We're currently hiring for the following roles:

Clinical Pharmacists

You'll provide safe, evidence-based medication services, verify medication orders or dispense medication accurately according to state and federal regulations, and document services in an accurate and timely manner. You'll need a PharmD or BS in Pharmacy, current OH licensure as an RPh (Board Certification preferred), and 2 years of post-grad pharmacy experience.

EVS and Patient Transport

You'll create a great first impression and help prevent infections for patients and their families by dusting, mopping and disinfecting hallways and patient rooms. You'll also safely transport patients to and from beds, wheelchairs, and stretchers, including patients with oxygen tanks and IV pumps. A high school diploma or GED is preferred.

Registered Nurses

You'll provide a blend of compassionate patient care with exceptional medical expertise and advanced technology in a variety of specialties. You'll need a BSN, current RN licensure in Ohio, at least 1 year of experience, and current BLS, ACLS and PALS certification.

Surgical Technicians

You'll perform scrub functions and assist in circulating duties under the direction of a Registered Nurse. You'll need Surgical Tech Program accreditation through CAAHEP or ABHES or TS-C or CST surgical technologist certification and current BLS certification.

Respiratory Therapists

You'll address, treat, care for and evaluate patients with respiratory insufficiency. You'll be a graduate of an accredited RT program, have a bachelor's degree, Ohio RCP Board licensure and RRT, BLS, ACLS and PALS certification.

Imaging

In one of these positions, you'll operate the equipment that exposes, develops and organizes x-ray film. You must be a graduate of an AMA-approved school of Radiologic Technology program and have ARRT certification in good standing, current Ohio RT licensure and BLS certification.

Laboratory

You'll be responsible for specimen handling and processing, test analyses, reporting, and maintaining records of patient test results. You'll need a bachelor's degree in biological sciences or medical technology and certification as an MT or need to be ASCP certification-eligible.

Police Officers

You'll support patients, visitors and caregivers 24/7 by providing a safe and secure environment. You'll need a high school diploma or GED, completion of Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy and an Ohio driver's license.
