Endovascular Elective Cerebral Aneurysm Repair Procedures

An elective cerebral aneurysm repair is a planned procedure to treat a weakened or enlarged blood vessel before it becomes an emergency. As with any surgery, there is a risk of complications, including bleeding, infection, heart problems, stroke, kidney problems or death. For these procedures, the overall complication rate in clinical studies is close to 8%; all Cleveland Clinic hospitals remain well below this rate.

The information below shows the rate of complications after elective aneurysm repair at Cleveland Clinic hospitals where these procedures are performed. Lower complication rates are better.
