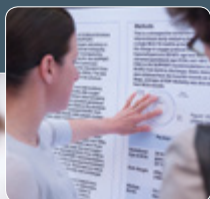

## Overview

### About the Conference

Nursing research and dissemination is a critical requirement of evidence-based nursing practice. There is a need to enhance nurses ability to plan, conduct and disseminate research. It is equally important for clinical nurses to network and share their research with academic and clinical researchers.

### **Gordon Gillespie, PhD, DNP, RN, FAEN, FAAN**

Gordon Gillespie, PhD, DNP, RN, FAEN, FAAN, is an Associate Professor in the College of Nursing at the University of Cincinnati. His research addresses traumatic stress related to workplace aggression and providing care to traumatically injured patients. Dr. Gillespie has served as chair for a national conference on workplace violence and as an editorial board member of the Advanced Emergency Nursing Journal.

### **Denice Sheehan, PhD, RN, FPCN**

Denice Sheehan, PhD, RN, FPCN, is an Associate Professor of Nursing at Kent State University. She also holds a joint position as the Director of Clinical Research at Hospice of the Western Reserve. Her research addresses the needs of the adolescent whose parent is terminally ill. Dr. Sheehan has contributed significantly to end of life care over the last three decades as a practitioner, educator and researcher.
