Purpose: The Zielony Nursing Institute Hannah Boland Award for Pediatric Clinical Excellence is presented in recognition of special skills, knowledge, dedication and compassion in the delivery of outstanding pediatric patient care.

Eligibility: Any Clinical Nurse (RN or LPN), Patient Care Nursing Assistant, Child Care Assistant, Medical Assistant or Clinical Technician employed for more than one year Cleveland Clinic Children's main campus, Children's Hospital for Rehabilitation, or in a pediatric department at a Family Health Center or ambulatory location reporting to Main Campus.

Process: Any employee, physician, patient or volunteer may nominate. Recipients will be selected on the basis of evidence provided by completion of the nomination eligibility criteria.

Award: The award winners will be announced and presented during Nurses' Week.

Instructions: Please **DO NOT** use the nominee's name when writing details: Address as the **NOMINEE**. Please cite specific examples including patient and physician comments. Answer each question completely, providing specific examples or descriptions as requested. When possible, provide quantitative data to support examples. If you require more space, attach a sheet to the nomination form.

1. Describe how the nominee participates in cooperative efforts, along with members of a group or team, to achieve a common goal in the care of children and their families.
2. Describe how the nominee demonstrates empathy and true concern for pediatric patients and their family members and provides a caring and supportive environment.
3. Describe how the nominee implemented a new or significantly improved idea, good, service, process or practice intended to be useful in the care of children and their families.
4. Describe how this nominee demonstrates commitment to patients and families by providing services that enhance patient and family satisfaction and positive clinical outcomes.
5. Provide examples showing how this nominee demonstrates superior interpersonal skills with patients, families, coworkers, and visitors.
