

Excellence in Nursing Ethics Award Enterprise Award

Purpose: Presented in recognition of the exemplary skills of providing and influencing an ethical patient care

environment that promotes patient values and goals.

Eligibility: Any nurse employed at Cleveland Clinic for at least one year. The nominee must have achieved

"commendable" or higher on their last annual performance review and have no corrective action in the last two years. Past NEA honorees are eligible in the same award category after 10 years and another

award category after 5 years.

Process: Any caregiver, patient or visitor may nominate. Submissions will be scored by Nursing Ethics program

faculty during a double-blind review based on evidence provided by completion of the nomination

questions. Honorees will be announced by the end of Nurses Week.

Instructions: Please **DO NOT** use the nominee's individual or team name when writing details but rather address as

the **NOMINEE**. Answer each question completely, providing specific examples or descriptions as requested, including patient and other caregiver comments. When possible, provide quantitative data to

support examples.

1. Describe how the nominee has modeled the provision of outstanding ethical patient care that aligns with the Cleveland Clinic Values.

2. Describe how the nominee has contributed to influencing an ethical patient care environment. Examples might be developing strong interprofessional collaborative processes or relationships to optimize ethical patient care.

3. Describe how the nominee has demonstrated the provision of ethical nursing care, drawing upon at least one of the 10 Provisions in the ANA Code of Ethics for Nurses (https://codeofethics.ana.org/provisions).
