ABOUT THE EXTERNSHIP:

During your externship, your experience will include working with a RN mentor, as well as classroom time. These classroom learning opportunities will include time spent with the larger group of Cleveland Clinic Nurse Associate Externs. In addition to time spent on your assigned unit, you will participate in a selection of clinical observation opportunities in both inpatient and outpatient settings.

With support from Cleveland Clinic's highly skilled team of nurses, you will have the chance to perform a wide range of tasks that further enhance your critical thinking and support you as a valued member of our healthcare team.

The Nurse Associate Externship program is available at various Cleveland Clinic health system locations.

WORK REQUIREMENTS:

The Nurse Associate Externship is a 10-week program offered during the summer months to nursing students entering their final semester(s) in a BSN program.

The program is available June 7, 2021 - August 14, 2021.

As a Nurse Associate Extern, you will be scheduled to work full time; 8-hour or 12-hour shifts following your RN mentor's shift and schedule.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Eligible students must:

- Be currently enrolled in an accredited nursing school BSN program and entering their last year or semester upon completion of the externship.
- Be in good standing with the nursing school throughout the nurse associate extern program.
- Have a current Basic Life Support (BLS) through the American Heart Association throughout the duration of the program.
- Complete a pre-hire screening process.
- Participate in an interview with a nurse manager.

Please provide a copy of your American Heart Association BLS Provider card or e-code with your application. If your card expires between now and Aug. 2021, please make arrangements to renew prior to the start of the program.
