

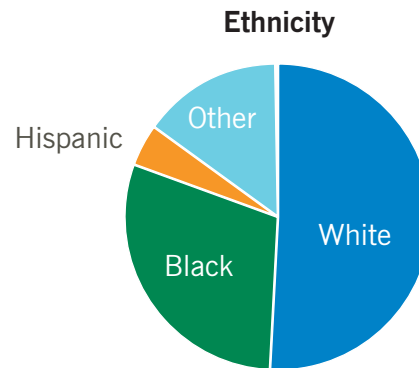

The WeeFIM® tool helps rehabilitation teams understand how independently a child can perform everyday activities — such as eating, moving around, getting dressed, communicating and solving problems.

The WeeFIM Total Change is the difference between a child's score at the start and end of rehab.

WeeFIM Mobility Score

The mobility part of the WeeFIM looks at how a child moves and gets from place to place. It focuses on how much help they need to move safely, whether getting out of bed, using the bathroom, walking or using a wheelchair.

WeeFIM Self-Care Score

The self-care section of the WeeFIM looks at how independently your child can manage basic daily needs. These are the everyday tasks all children work toward doing. The skills assessed include:

- Eating
- Grooming
- Bathing
- Dressing – upper body
- Dressing – lower body
- Toileting
- Bowel management
- Bladder management

WeeFIM Cognition Score

The cognition section of the WeeFIM looks at how a child understands, communicates, interacts and thinks through daily activities. These skills help a child learn, follow directions, solve problems and connect with others. The cognition area includes five key skills:

- Comprehension (understanding information)
- Expression (communicating needs and ideas)
- Social interaction
- Problem solving
- Memory
