Cleveland Clinic is a nonprofit, multispecialty academic medical center that integrates clinical and hospital care with research and education. Cleveland Clinic was founded in 1921 by four renowned physicians with a vision of providing outstanding patient care based on the principles of cooperation, compassion, and innovation. Today, Cleveland Clinic is one of the largest and most respected hospitals in the country.

Cleveland Clinic is a 6,000-bed health system that includes a 173-acre main campus near downtown Cleveland, along with 24 hospitals, more than 220 outpatient facilities, and locations in southeast Florida; Las Vegas, Nevada; Toronto, Canada; Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates; and London, England.

The pharmacy department at Cleveland Clinic has over 1,500 pharmacy employees, 21 ambulatory pharmacies, and significant inpatient and outpatient clinical services. We offer several PGY-1 and PGY-2 pharmacy residency programs.

Cleveland Clinic Indian River,

part of Cleveland Clinic's Florida market, is a 322-bed hospital in Vero Beach. Specialties include orthopaedics, heart and vascular medicine, neurosurgery, stroke, gastroenterology, bariatrics, oncology, emergency medicine, and labor and delivery. Cleveland Clinic Indian River is comprised of locations across Indian River County that include outpatient facilities, urgent care centers, and ambulatory pharmacies.

Cleveland Clinic Martin Health

is also part of Cleveland Clinic's Florida market. It features three hospitals: Cleveland Clinic Martin North Hospital, Cleveland Clinic Martin South Hospital, and Cleveland Clinic Tradition Hospital. These hospitals boast a total of 521 beds, a free-standing emergency center, and numerous outpatient centers and clinics across Martin and St. Lucie counties on Florida's east coast. Cleveland Clinic Martin Health offers preventive, primary and acute hospital care, as well as cancer care, a heart center, wellness and rehabilitation services, and much more.

Cleveland Clinic Weston

Hospital is a 258-bed nonprofit, multispecialty academic medical center in Cleveland Clinic's Florida market that integrates clinical and hospital care with research and education. With locations in Weston, Fort Lauderdale, Coral Springs, Parkland, West Palm Beach, Wellington, and Palm Beach Gardens, Cleveland Clinic Weston Hospital has more than 365 physicians with expertise in 55 specialties. The medical campus is fully integrated and includes diagnostic centers, outpatient surgery, and a 24-hour emergency department located in the state-of-the-art hospital.
