# **Cleveland Clinic** Inpatient Pharmacy Internship Program

#### **Our Purpose**

The Cleveland Clinic Department of Pharmacy aspires to be the world leader in pharmacy practice. To do so, we believe in providing **world-class experiences** that will prepare student pharmacists for their post-graduation goals.

The Main Campus inpatient program will prepare interns to become pharmacy practitioners that embody **excellence in education, clinical care, and personal integrity**. ### **Program Details**

**When:** This longitudinal program is a **year-round paid internship** consisting of 12-weeks of summer components from May-August and an average of one out of every four weekends throughout the academic year. Internship **start and end dates are customizable** based on final exam schedules and departmental needs.

**What:** The internship will cultivate a **highly translatable skill set** through clinical and operational experiences. All interns will start rotations in pharmacy operations and progress to clinical experiences. Clinical rotations available include internal medicine, cardiology, emergency medicine, and critical care with electives in other clinical areas based on preceptor availability.

Every intern has the opportunity to participate in **research**, **projects**, **and presentations**.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for selection, students must enrolled in an ACPE-accredited doctor of pharmacy program (either 1st/2nd year student in a 4-year program or 3rd/4th year student in a 6-year program).

Students must be eligible for an intern license in the state of Ohio. If selected, the student will be required to obtain their license by April 1, 2025 and maintain for the duration of their employment.

Applicants will be evaluated on various parameters including career goals, prior experience, communication skills, and the ability to work in a dynamic team atmosphere. **Candidates should be available for a 30-minute Microsoft Teams interview in April.**
