

PGY2 Ambulatory Care Residency

Program Purpose

PGY2 Purpose: PGY2 residency programs build upon Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and PGY1 pharmacy residency training to develop pharmacist practitioners with knowledge, skills, and abilities as defined in the educational competency areas, goals, and objectives for advanced practice areas. Residents who successfully complete PGY2 residency programs are prepared for advanced patient care or other specialized positions, and board certification in the advanced practice area, if available.

Program Structure

Residency program experiences include a combination of concentrated and longitudinal rotation experiences. Residents must complete 2 elective rotations. Availability of experiences are as follows:

Pharmacogenomics	4 weeks	Elective	First or second half of year
Pharmacy Administration 2	4 weeks	Elective	First or second half of year
Pulmonary	4 weeks	Elective	First of second half of year
Rheumatology	4 weeks	Elective	First or second half of year
Specialty Pharmacy	4 weeks	Elective	First of second half of year
Transplant	4 weeks	Elective	First of second half of year
Research Project	Longitudinal (1 year)- 2-5 hours per week	Required	N/A
Teaching/Presentations	Longitudinal (1 year)- 2-5 hours per month	Required	N/A
