

Program Purpose

PGY2 Program Purpose: PGY2 residency programs build upon Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and PGY1 pharmacy residency training to develop pharmacist practitioners with knowledge, skills, and abilities as defined in the educational competency areas, goals, and objectives for advanced practice areas. Residents who successfully complete PGY2 residency programs are prepared for advanced patient care or other specialized positions, and board certification in the advanced practice area, if available.

Program Structure for 2024-2025

Residency program experiences include a combination of concentrated, extended, and longitudinal rotation experiences. Residents must complete all required rotations and 2 elective rotations. Availability of experiences are as follows:

Resident On-call	Longitudinal (minimum 10 times/year = 240 hours/year) ²	Required	N/A
Presentations	Longitudinal (2 – 5 hr/month¹ depending on schedule)	Required	N/A
Committees and Leadership	Longitudinal (2 – 5 hr/month¹)	Required	N/A
DUE / Small Project	Longitudinal (1 – 2 hr/month ¹)	Required	N/A
Research / Large Project	Longitudinal (2 – 5 hr/week 1)	Required	N/A
