Pediatric Outpatient Clinic	Longitudinal, second half of year starting in Jan (1/2 day-two days/month)	Required	N/A
Pediatric Staffing Weekends	Longitudinal, yearlong (30, 8-hour shifts)	Required	N/A
Large Project	Longitudinal, yearlong, (~3-5 hours/week) See research timeline for details	Required	N/A
Small Project	Longitudinal, yearlong (~2-3 hours/week) See research timeline for details	Required	N/A
Pediatric Leadership and Formulary Management	Longitudinal, yearlong (~1-2 hours/month)	Required	N/A
Presentations/Education	Longitudinal, yearlong (~2-5 hours/month)	Required	N/A
On-Call	Longitudinal, yearlong (successful completion 10 shifts per year, 6-hour shifts)	Required	N/A
Pediatric Medical Emergency	Longitudinal, yearlong (~1-2 hours/month)	Required	N/A

\*Only two intensive care unit rotations are required. Residents may pick from the following: pediatric intensive care, pediatric cardiac intensive care or neonatal intensive care
