



Requirements for Successful Completion of Residency Program

Criteria	Completed Date	
Ascertainment of Ohio pharmacist licensure as soon as possible, but must be licensed within 90 days of start date		
Successful completion in each of the required rotation areas (see program structure)		
Completion of all PharmAcademic evaluations		
Completion of required patient care experiences as required by Competencies and Goals Appendix		
Completion of a residency research project		
Completion of at least one drug use evaluation (DUE), quality improvement project, or medication safety project		
Completion and presentation of at least one formulary review monograph		
A manuscript (in publishable form) written and submitted to the residency director prior to the end of the residency year		
Present according to the schedule agreed upon by both the Resident and Residency Program Director at the beginning of the residency year (including presentations at resident conference, APPE student conference, and Peds Quarterly)
