

# **Expected Main Campus Closures during the Presidential Debate\***

Cleveland Clinic has been working closely with the City of Cleveland, the Secret Service, the Commission on Presidential Debates, and the Cleveland Police Department to ensure the safety of all attending, visiting and working at our main campus. To support our operations and the safety of all involved, there will be several building, entrance and road closures around campus.

# **Entrances**

Beginning Friday, September 25, at 8 p.m., the main entrance to the J Building - Sydell & Arnold Miller Family Pavilion will close. Our temporary main entrance will be the Q Building -Glickman Tower on East 96th Street.

Beginning **Saturday, September 26**, the main entrance to our R Building - Cleveland Clinic Children's Outpatient Center on Euclid Avenue will close. It will be temporarily replaced by the entrance on East 90th Street.

### Changes to Health Education Campus

Samson Pavilion will be closed for academic use from September 26 – September 30.

# Parking

#### Beginning Saturday, September 26, closures include:

The P1 Parking Garage on East 93rd Street, also known as the JJ Parking Garage. JJ offices will be closed for normal business operations. The Euclid Avenue Pharmacy will have limited access on Tuesday, September 29 to only those picking up prescriptions.

Patients and visitors are advised to use our P2 Parking Garage, located on East 100th Street. While we expect that there will be unusually high congestion on Carnegie Avenue due to street closures associated with the Presidential Debates, we believe that self-parking in the P-2 garage will best support your arrival and departure.

# Street closures and access routes

Northbound East 93rd Street is closed between Euclid and Chester Avenues as of Tuesday, September 22.

#### Starting the morning of Friday, September 25:

**Chester Avenue** between East 89th and East 105th Streets will close in both directions.

### Starting Friday, September 25, at 6 p.m.:

**Euclid Avenue** between East 89th and East 105th Streets will close in both directions.

East 90th, East 96th and East 100th Streets between Euclid and Chester Avenues will close in both directions.

**East 100th Street** between Carnegie and Euclid Avenues will be restricted to northbound traffic only to support the temporary main entrance at Q Building - Glickman Tower. East 100th Street will be closed at Euclid Avenue.

**East 101st Street** between Euclid and Chester Avenues will remain open, but will only be accessible from westbound Chester Avenue.

### Normal operations are expected to resume on Thursday, October 1.

- **Euclid and Chester Avenues** will open in both directions.
- East 96th Street between Carnegie and Euclid Avenues will reopen.
- **All remaining road closures** will reopen.
- P1 garage on East 93rd Street will reopen.
- **All hospital entrances** will reopen.
