



What is an Echocardiogram?





An echocardiogram (echo) is a test to check:





· How well your heart is pumping blood




• The size of the 4 chambers of your heart



- If you have any growths in your heart
- · How well your plan of care is working





Echocardiogram Test Preparation

How do I prepare for the test?

No changes to eating and drinking



Take all your normal medications




Wear anything you like. You will wear a hospital gown for the test




What is an Echocardiogram?






How is the test done?

- You will lie on a special table
- Three small, sticky patches are put on your chest to record your heartbeat (rate and rhythm)
- You will lay on your left side
- The person doing the test will put gel on the end of a wand
- He or she will move the wand over your chest.
 The gel may feel cool on your skin.



- You may need to change positions and hold your breath at times
- The test does not hurt





How long does the test take?

• The test takes about 1 hour
