Please note, to protect our patients and prevent the spread of infections, these are our current guidelines surrounding donations:

- 1. All donations must be brand new, odor-free, in original packaging and purchased within the last 3-6 months.
- 2. All books and stuffed animal donations must be new and unused.
- 3. Due to acute illness of our patients, we are unable to allow donors to personally distribute gifts to the children.
- 4. Donations must be scheduled in advance. Contact information for Main Campus, Fairview, and Hillcrest hospitals is listed online.
- 5. To be inclusive of all patients at Cleveland Clinic Children's, we are unable to accept donations for specific diagnoses. Donations received will be distributed to pediatric patients from all departments.
- 6. To spread cheer to families of all backgrounds and belief systems, please refrain from donating religious material.
- 7. All items must come from smoke-free, dust-free, and pet-free environments.
- 8. Please keep all gifts unwrapped.
- 9. Please buy specific name brands whenever possible.
- 10. Please avoid toys with detachable parts that could be removed and swallowed. Avoid toys which can break and leave sharp edges.
- 11. Art & craft materials must have the non-toxic seal (AP, CP, Health Label Non-Toxic)

12. We cannot accept:

- a. Violent themed items (i.e. items containing guns, swords, blood, violence, etc.)
- b. Handwritten or homemade cards or letters (it means more to our patients and families to receive blank cards so they can make their own).
- c. Items with cloth are not permitted. Toys must be plastic or have a washable surface.
- d. Items known to contain rubber latex, including, but not limited to; rubber balls, rubber stamps, rubber balloons, rubber erasers, etc.
- e. Popular collector items that have been gathered and stored.
- f. Candy, food, or religious material
