It includes the Lerner School for Autism, center-based outpatient services - diagnostic evaluations, speech/language, occupational and applied behavioral analysis therapies (behavior therapy) in the region, and federally-funded clinical research. Our center provides services from earliest diagnosis through 21 years of age.

Serving children at six dedicated pediatric therapy locations. Physical, occupational and speech/language therapists serve infants and children through age 21, with assistance from recreational, art and music therapists and adaptive equipment specialists. We treat the most complex conditions in specialized clinics focusing on constraint-induced movement therapy, feeding disorders, seating and wheelchair therapy, and upper extremity disorders.

Feeding disorders develop from a combination of medical/physiological, developmental, behavioral and psychosocial factors. As many as 25% of children experience some type of feeding difficulty during infancy or early childhood. The incidence can be as high as 33% for children with developmental disabilities.

The Day Therapy Program at Cleveland Clinic Children's Hospital for Rehabilitation offers intensive therapy without requiring an overnight stay. Children receive a combination of medical, nursing and therapy services during the day, and return home each evening and weekend.
