	Completion of a residency project (Large)																										
	Completion of at least one drug use evaluation (DUE) or quality improvement project (Small)																										
	A manuscript (in publishable form) written and submitted to the residency director																										
	Completion of at least one formulary review monograph																										
	Present according to the schedule agreed upon by both the Resident and Residency Program Director at the beginning of the residency year (including presentation of case presentations, journal clubs, continuing education topics, seminar, research proposal and findings, DUE proposal and findings, and presentation at Critical Care Conference)																										
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	Attend American College of Cardiology Spring Meeting.																										
	Optionally attend/present at Ohio College of Clinical Pharmacy (OCCP) Fall/Spring meeting, and Great Lakes Pharmacy Residency Conference																										
	Staffing (both Saturday and Sunday) for a total of 15 staffing weekends (30 eight-hour shifts) during the residency year. Additionally, staffing one major and one minor holiday each (each with an eight-hour shift).																										
	Achieve all goals in R1 (or specific R domain for patient care). A resident may have 2 goals in other domains that are not achieved. And by the end of the residency, there can be no objectives that are rated as Needs Improvement.
