## 2025-2026 PGY2 Critical Care Residency Program Purpose and Structure

### **Purpose Statement**

PGY2 Critical Care pharmacy residency program builds on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and PGY1 pharmacy residency programs to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists in advanced or specialized practice. PGY2 residencies provide residents with opportunities to function independently as practitioners by conceptualizing and integrating accumulated experience and knowledge and incorporating both into the provision of patient care that improves medication therapy. Residents who successfully complete an accredited PGY2 pharmacy residency should possess competencies that qualify them for clinical pharmacist and/or faculty positions and position them to be eligible for attainment of board certification in the specialized practice area (i.e. BCCCP).

The goal of the PGY2 Critical Care training program at Cleveland Clinic is to develop an expert-level practitioner with the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities to thrive as a Critical Care Clinical Specialist, Clinical Faculty Member, or to pursue fellowship training in critical care. Residency program experiences include a combination of concentrated, extended, and longitudinal rotation experiences. Residents must complete 25 weeks of elective rotations. Availability of experiences are as follows:
