

Program Purpose

The Infectious Diseases PGY2 pharmacy residency programs build on Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and PGY1 pharmacy residency programs to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists in specialized areas of practice. PGY2 residencies provide residents with opportunities to function independently as practitioners by conceptualizing and integrating accumulated experience and knowledge and incorporating both into the provision of patient care or other advanced practice settings. Residents who successfully complete an accredited PGY2 pharmacy residency are prepared for advanced patient care, academic, or other specialized positions, along with board certification in Infectious Diseases pharmacy.

Program Structure

Residency program experiences include a combination of concentrated and longitudinal rotation experiences. Availability of experiences are as follows:

Research Project	Longitudinal, yearlong, (~3-5 hours/week) plus 4 weeks concentrated research time. See research timeline for details	Required	N/A
Presentations/Education	Longitudinal, yearlong (~2-5 hours/month)	Required	N/A
On-Call	Longitudinal, yearlong (approximately 15 shifts/year)	Required	N/A
