

Requirements for Successful Completion of Residency Program

Criteria	Completed Date																																				
Ascertainment of Ohio pharmacist licensure as soon as possible, but must be licensed within 90 days of start date																																					
Successful completion in each of the required rotation areas (see program structure)																																					
Completion of required patient care experiences as required by Competencies and Goals Appendix																																					
Completion of a residency research project																																					
Completion of at least one drug use evaluation (DUE), quality improvement project, or medication safety project																																					
Completion and presentation of at least one formulary review monograph																																					
A manuscript (in publishable form) written and submitted to the residency director prior to the end of the residency year
